ANKLE FRACTURE POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

Weight-Bearing

1. Please do not bear any weight on the operated ankle until you first follow-up visit.
2. You may gently place your leg on the ground for balance.

Boot

1. Please keep the boot on until your follow up appointment.
2. The straps on the boot may be loosened for comfort.
3. You may remove the boot to change the dressing (see Wound Care below), but please put it back on after changing the dressing.

Surgical Dressing (Bandages) and Wound Care

1. The surgical dressing (bandages) consist of an Ace Wrap and gauze. Please remove the bandages on the second day after surgery.
2. PLEASE NOTE: It is normal for there to be some blood or drainage on the gauze bandages.
3. Depending on how your skin was closed, you may see staples, stitches, or small bandaids (Steri-strips) below the gauze.
4. After you have removed the bandage, please re-cover it using either clean gauze and tape or clean gauze and ace wrap.
5. Please do not apply any ointments or lotions on or around the surgical incision.
5. Please put the boot back on after changing the dressing.

Showering/Bathing

1. Please keep the surgical area dry until your follow-up appointment
2. When showering or bathing, please cover the surgical site with plastic. You may either use a plastic bag and tape or a commercially available wound protector.
3. If the surgical incisions get wet, please dry them gently.

Please call the office at 877-314-8990 to arrange or confirm your post-operative appointment.

Please call the office if you are experiencing any of the following:

- Excessive drainage from your surgical incision
- Fever
- Increased redness of your skin surrounding the incision
- Pain that cannot be controlled with your pain medications
